

Student Visa Requirements for International Students to Indonesia

Option 1: Arrive on a tourist visa. Visa on Arrival (VOA) is available for most countries. Upon your arrival, MIBT Indonesia will assist with the student visa application process. Note this option will entail a short (1 day) visit to Singapore or another neighbouring country to process the visa application.

Option 2: Obtain a student visa prior to arriving in Indonesia. Please provide by email to admissions@mibt.or.id:

1. Completed Application Form (available from www.mibt.or.id).
2. Copy of all pages of the passport (must be valid for at least 18 months).
3. Copy of most recent school reports.
4. CV/resume summarizing educational experience (not employment experience).
5. Standard-sized digital passport photograph with a red background (digital copy must be provided in order to print multiple copies required by immigration).
6. Evidence of payment of tuition fees (first semester – based on the Letter of Offer from MIBT Indonesia).
7. Financial statement from parent/guardian (MIBT Indonesia can provide sample).
8. Letter from a doctor stating applicant is in good health.

Following submission of the above, MIBT Indonesia can process the visa application. This takes approximately 4-6 weeks. Costs incurred by MIBT Indonesia for visa processing (approximately A\$450) are payable upon enrollment.

Note: MIBT Indonesia arranges airport pickup and provides assistance with accommodation.
