



**PLEASE READ:**

**Conditions for Deferred Examinations**

A deferred examination may be granted in extenuating circumstances if a student is unable to sit a scheduled examination.

To be granted a deferred examination the following conditions **must** be satisfied:

1. The student **must** have attended at least 80% of the schedule classes in the unit.
2. The student **must** have completed the trimester assessment requirements as specified in the unit outline.
3. The extenuating circumstances must be significant and be supported by evidence.

Applications for Deferred Examinations will be accepted on medical, compassionate, and/or trauma grounds. Support evidence, clearly stating specific reasons, **must** be given with the application. Headaches, colds, examination nerves, 'medical condition', arriving late for the examination, misreading of the examination timetable, public transport did not run, returning home, **will not** be accepted as grounds for a Deferred examination.

Deferred examination will be held within two weeks after the scheduled examination period has finished.
